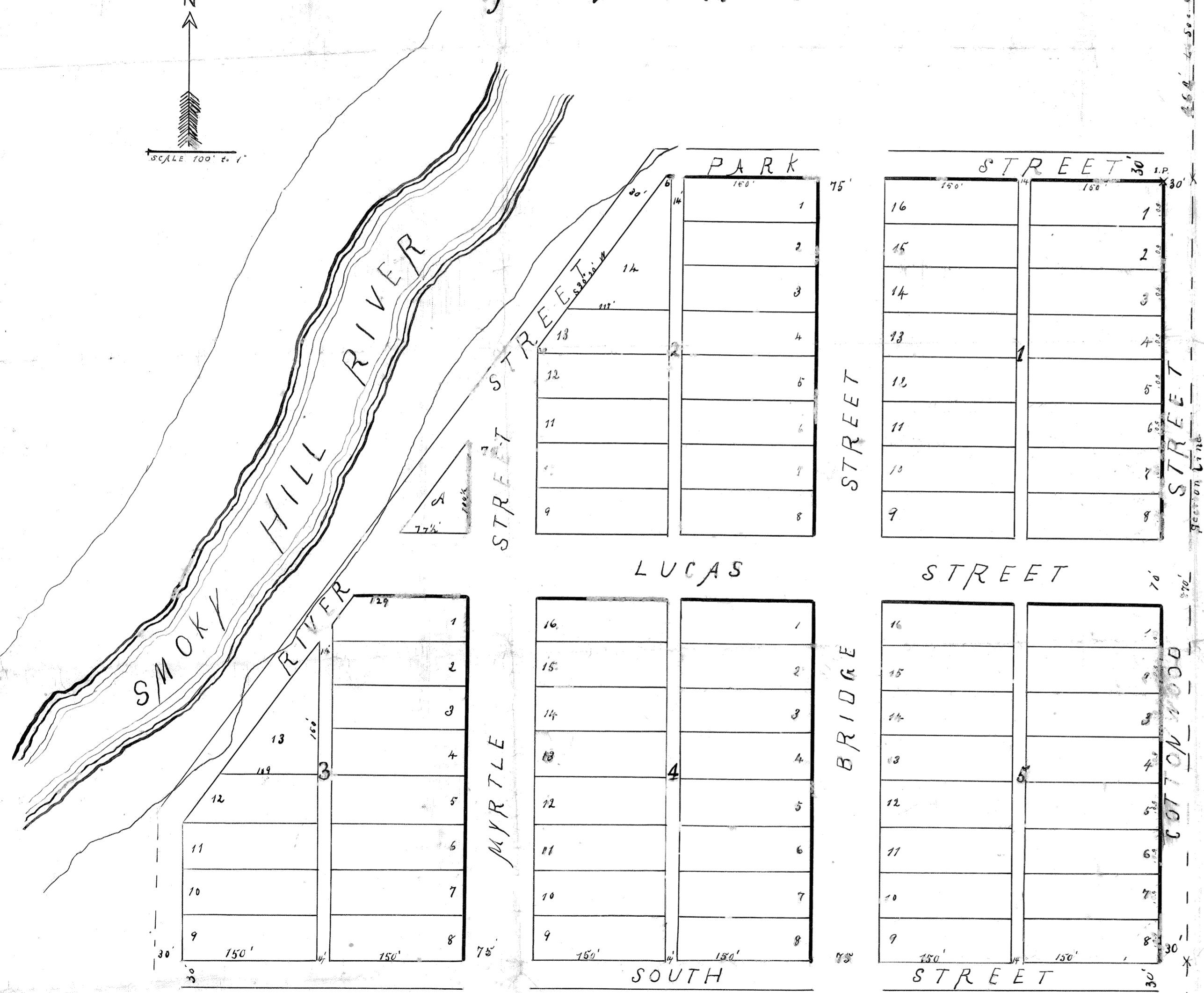
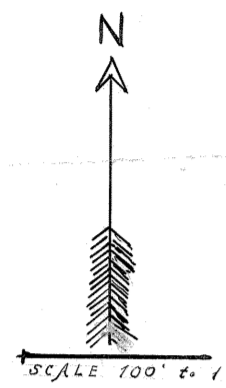


# BACON'S ADDITION

## to MARQUETTE



Bacon's Addition to Marquette is located on the East Half of the North East Quarter of Section Twenty Six (26) Town Seventeen (17) Range Five (5) West of 6th P. M. The initial point is at the North East corner of Block One (1) and is Four hundred and Sixty Four (464) feet South of the corner to Secs 23, 24, 25 & 26 and Thirty (30) feet West of the section line between Secs 25 & 26 and is divided into Blocks, Lots, Streets and Alleys as shown by this Plat. All lots are 50 X 150 feet unless fractional and otherwise marked.
