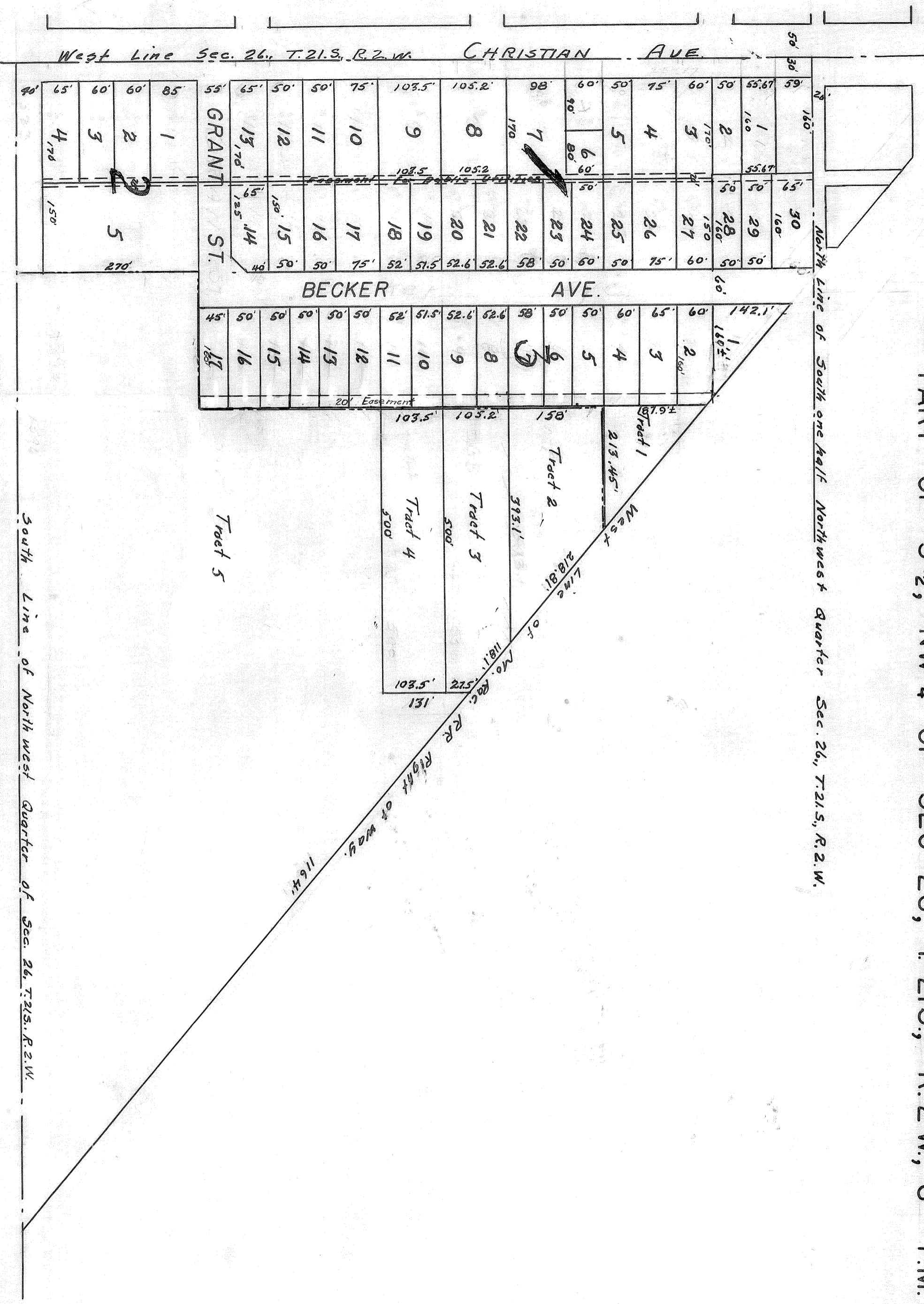


BECKER SUBDIVISION
