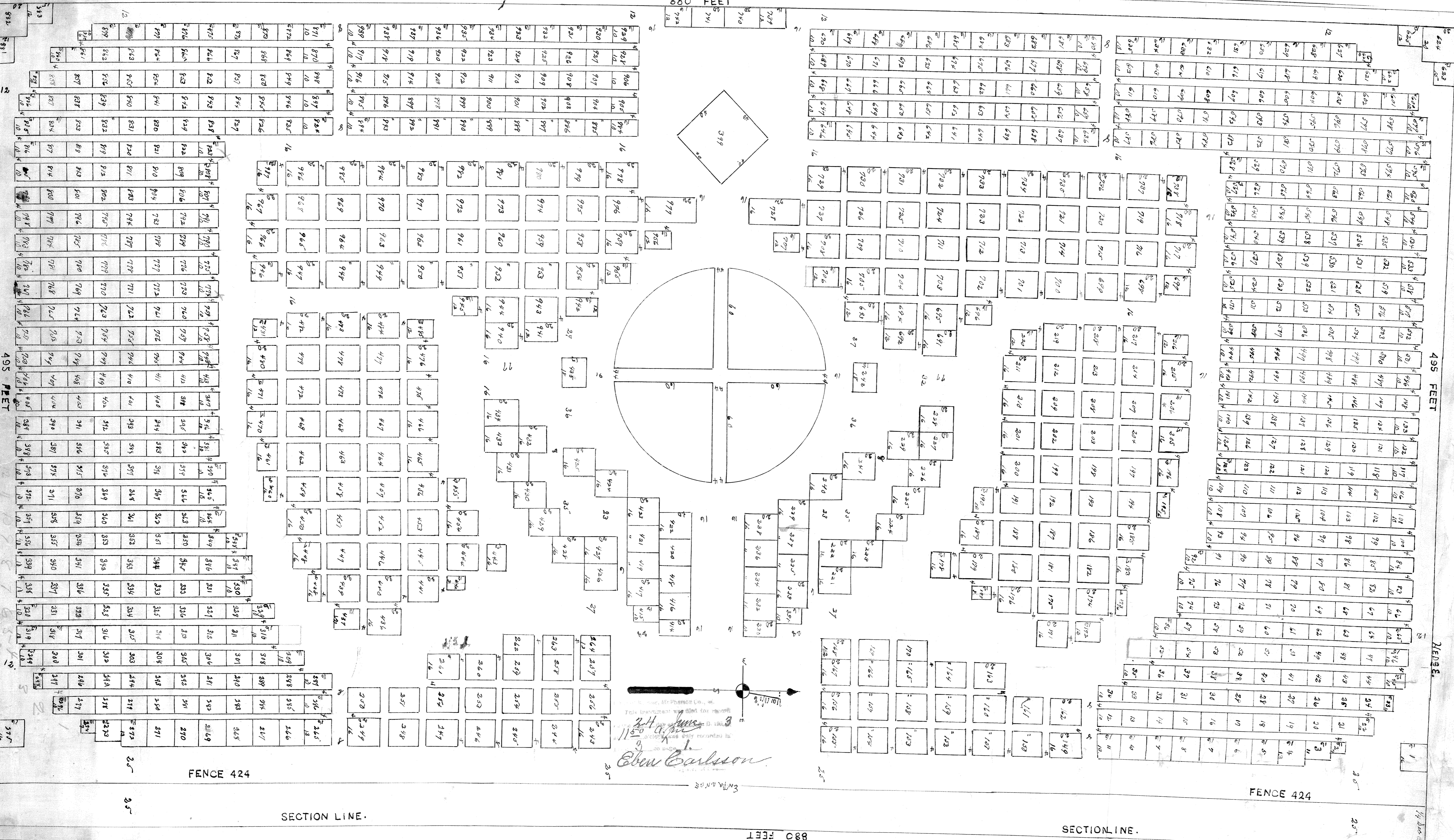

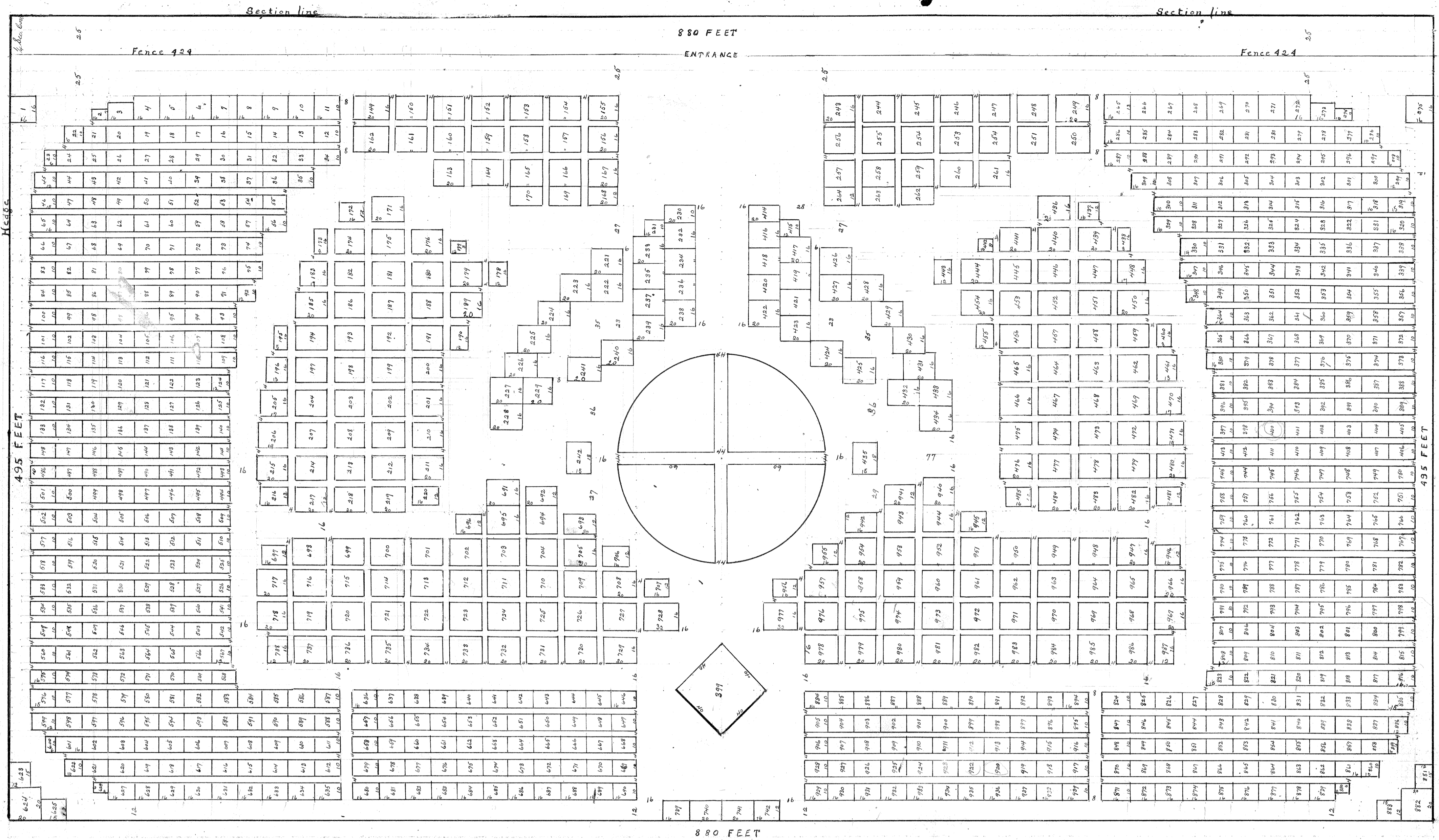

The area of Canton Cemetery is Ten acres described as follows: Beginning at the 1/4 Section corner common to Sections 15 and 16, Town. 19 South, and of Range 1 West of the 6th P. M. thence South on Section line between Sections 15 and 16 Eight Hundred Eighty (880) feet, thence West Four Hundred Ninety five (495) feet, thence North parallel with the East line of Section 16 Eight Hundred Eighty (880) feet, thence East on the 1/4 Section line Four Hundred Ninety five (495) feet and to the place of beginning. The same being a part of the South East Quarter of Section 16, Town. 19, Range 1 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, and is subdivided as is shown by the annexed plat.

The Canton Cemetery Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Kansas, having its office in the City of Canton, Kansas, and the lawful owner of the above described land, has dedicated said land and executed the annexed plat for the purpose of a cemetery.
