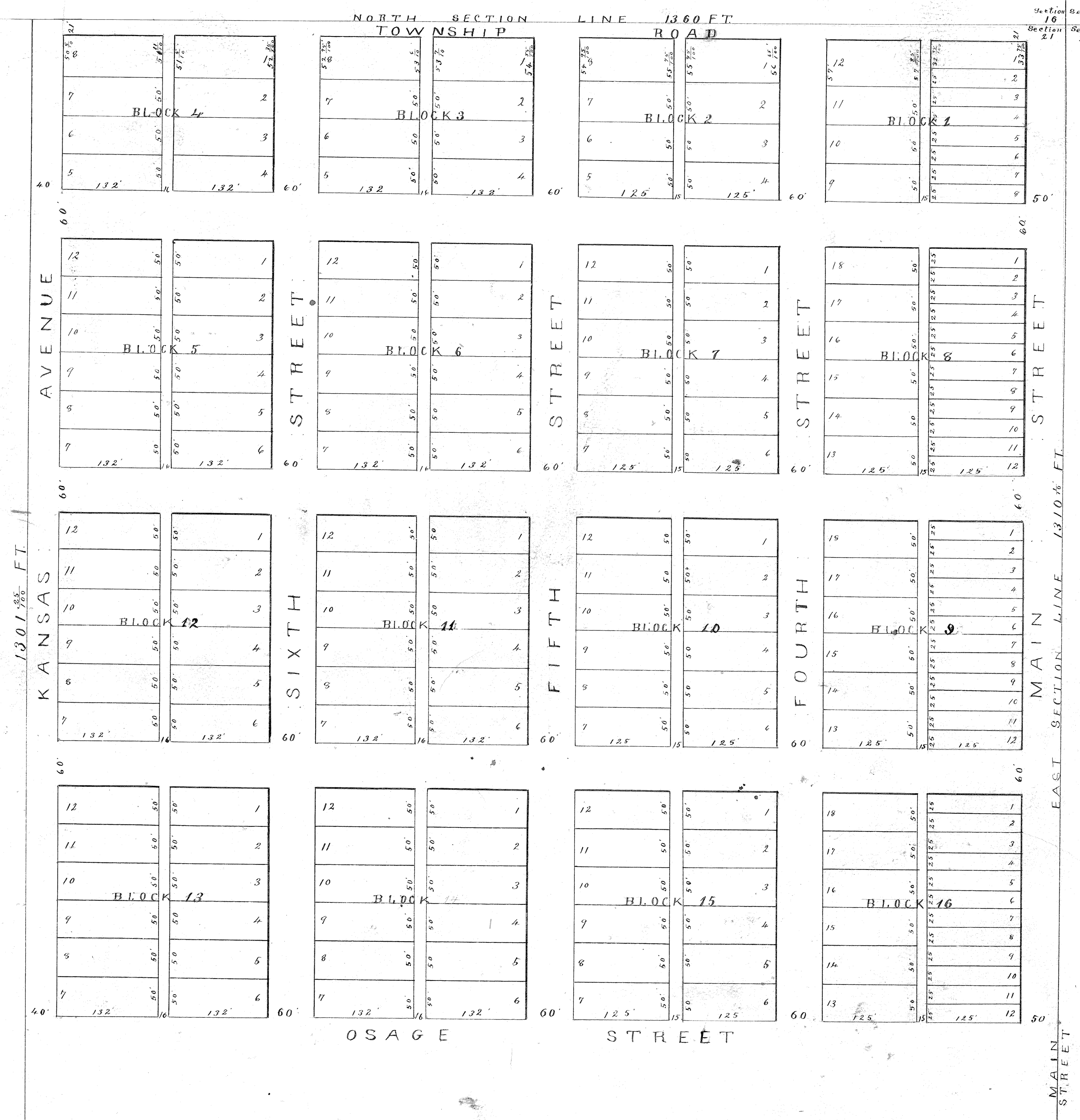

The Initial point of this survey is the North East corner of Section 21, Township 19 South of Range One West of the Sixth Principal Meridian in the State of Kansas, County of McPherson, Canton Township, Thence southerly on the East line of said section 1310 1/2 feet to the North line of Osage Street of the City of Canton in said Township, Thence Westward on the north line of Osage Street 1360 feet to the center of Kansas Avenue of the said City of Canton, Thence Northward 1301 3/4 feet to the North line of said section, Thence Easterly on said North line 1360 feet to the Initial point.

The above mentioned is divided by streets, Avenues or Roads of the width as set forth by numbers expressing the number of feet into Blocks numbered from 1 to 16 both inclusive.

The Blocks are subdivided by Alleys of the width as set forth by numbers therein expressing the number of feet and the Blocks are further subdivided into Lots and marked by a numeral at or near the North East corner of each and every lot.

The length of each lot is uniform and the numeral in the south part of the South Lots of each Block expresses the number of feet.

The widths of lots that are uniform at the numeral in the West part of the lot expresses the number of feet.

The widths of the North lots in Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4 the numeral in the West and East part expresses the number of feet for their respective parts.

The Base Line for the divisions and subdivisions is the North line of Osage Street of the City of Canton.

The Meridian Line for the divisions and subdivisions is East line of Section 21 above described.
