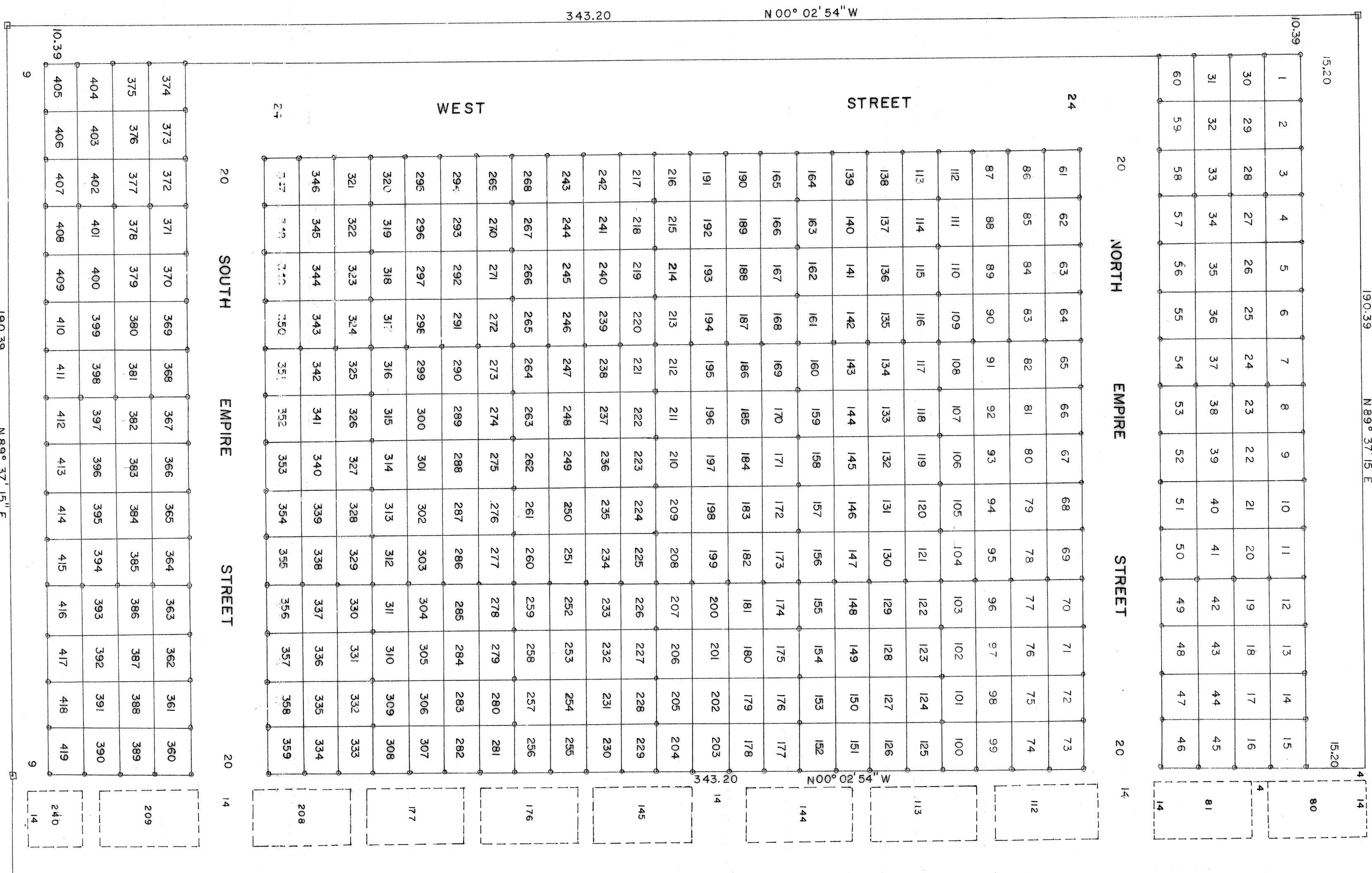


SECOND ADDITION

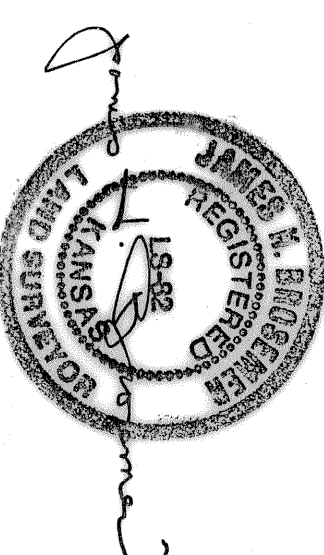
SURVEYORS CERTIFICATE

This is to certify and acknowledge that I, James H. Brosemer, a registered land surveyor in said County and State, prepared and monumented this plat of Second Addition to Empire Cemetery, said plat encompasses the following described tract, (70) tract in the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Three (3), Township 23 North, Range 20 West, (417.5 feet) South 89 degrees 37 minutes 15 seconds West of the Northeast corner of said SE 1/4 of Section 3; thence Continuing South 89 degrees 37 minutes 15 seconds West, a distance of 190.39 feet; thence South, a distance of 20.8 rods (343.2 feet); thence North 89 degrees 37 minutes 15 seconds East, a distance of 190.39 feet; thence North a distance of 20.8 rods (343.2 feet) to beginning, said tract containing 1.9 acres.

The Plat contains 419 lots that are 9.0 feet North & South by 12.0 feet East & West. North and South Empire Streets are 20 feet wide, West Street is 24 feet wide.
