*Drain-moment Obliteration* to *Dr. Pherson* is a subdivision into lots of Fairmount Addition and is located on the North East Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Stanton (19) Range Three (3) West of the 6th R. 26, and comprises all of said north East Quarter (1/4) except the Right of Way of the former and South Western Rail Road, and is divided into lots Blocks, Streets, Alleys and Ways as shown by the above plat.

Blocks 1, 2, 3 and 4 are identical with Blocks of the same number in Drain-moment Subdivision; Blocks 11, 12, 13 and 14 are the same as Blocks 7, 8, 9 and 10; Blocks 15, 16, 17 and 18 are the same as 11, 12, 13 and 14; Blocks 25, 26, 27 and 28 are the same as 17, 18, 19 and 20; Blocks 5, 6 and 7 are a subdivision of Block 5; Blocks 8, 9 and 10 are a subdivision of Block 6; 19, 20 and 21 of Block 15 and 22, 23 and 24 of Block 16
