"A Plat supplementary to Fair-view an addition to the City of Canton, McPherson County, State of Kansas on the North West part of the North East Quarter of Section 21 Town 19 South of Range one West in said county and state" Being the Divisions and subdivisions of Block 1 and 2 according to Plat of said Fair-view. Filed in Registers of Deeds office of said County January 27th 1887.

Surveyors Description.

Block 1 of the Original Plat of Fair-view (to which this is supplementary) is extended West to the West line of the North East quarter of Section 21 Town 19 South of Range one West in McPherson County, State of Kansas, and said Block 1 is extended south to the North line of Block 2 of said Original Plat.

Block One in this Plat is by streets of extent indicated by Numerals thereon, Divided into Ranges 1-2-3-and-4, These Ranges and also Block 2 are divided into Lots, there Numerals expressed by the numeral near the North East corner of each Lot. The extent of each lot is expressed by numerals and near the South and West lines of the Range or Lot.

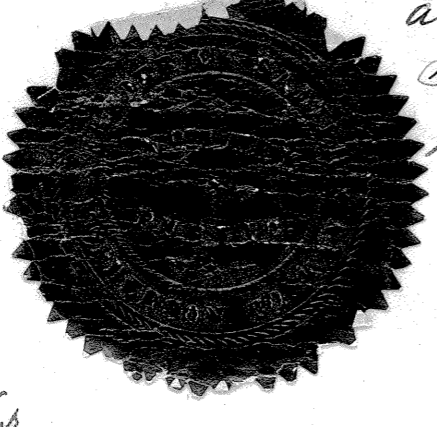
All Numerals with their Decimals for measurement express the Number of Feet, The East and South boundary lines of this plat are the Base and Meridian for the Divisions and Subdivisions.

Know ye that the "Canton Improvement Company" a Corporation existing under and by the Laws of the State of Kansas, are proprietors of the Land hereinbefore described in and by Plat and Surveyors Description and they by their President William O Gray do hereby set apart for Public use all streets their course and extent, being as therein expressed except such portions as are subject to the Chicago Kansas and Nebraska Company's Right of Way of a width not to exceed Two Hundred feet, and subject to the same exception are reserved for private use all Lots they being intended for sale.
