


# FIRST ADDITION TO EMPIRE CEMETERY.



Know all men by these Presents, That the Empire Cemetery Association of McPherson Co., and State of Kansas incorporated under the laws of the state of Kansas, the first addition to Empire Cemetery is located as shown by the foregoing plan the same being a description of said plot situated on the south east 1/4 Sec. 3, Twp 20 Range 20 West S.P. Meridian containing 2 acres, and platted into lots 20 by 25 ft. excepting West tier which are 14 by 25 feet and South tier 14 by 20 feet. Wagon Streets are 14 feet wide. Center alley 6 feet wide. North Center Alley 4 feet wide. South Center Alley 4 feet wide. And that the said Empire Cemetery Association has caused the said land to be surveyed and platted as shown by plan. The same being in accordance with the design and instructions of said Association.
