

Know all men by these Presents: That The Kansas Town and Land Company being the owner of that part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section nine (9) township twenty-one (21) south of range four (4) west in McPherson County, Kansas described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of said southwest quarter of the south west quarter of section nine (9) hence west three hundred and sixty three and five tenths feet (.335), hence north seven hundred and eighty (780) feet, hence west to the right of way of the Chicago, Kansas and Nebraska Railway, hence north east along said right of way to a point which is twenty-one and one tenth (.21) feet south of the north line of said south west quarter of the south west quarter of section nine (9) hence east twelve and one tenth (.21) feet to place of beginning, above the owner of that part of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section nine (9) township twenty-one (21) south of range four (4) west, McPherson County, Kansas described as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section nine (9) hence south forty (40) feet, hence north five hundred and twenty-five and five tenths (.525) feet, hence west three hundred and sixty seven (.67) feet, hence north forty (40) feet, hence east, plus hundred sixty seven (.67) feet to place of beginning, above the owner of that part of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section sixteen (16) of township twenty-one (21) south of range four (4) west, McPherson County, Kansas described as follows: Beginning at a point on the east line of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section sixteen (16) which is twenty-four (24) feet north of the northeast corner thereof, hence west thirteen hundred and twenty-five and five tenths (.325) feet, hence east, plus hundred and sixty seven (.67) feet, hence north two hundred and forty (240) feet, hence east, plus hundred and sixty seven (.67) feet, hence south to place of beginning, above the owner of that part of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section seventeen (17) of township twenty-one (21) south of range four (4) west, McPherson County, Kansas described as follows: Beginning at a point on the east line of said northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section seventeen (17) which is twenty-four (24) feet north of the south east corner thereof, hence west to the right of way of the Chicago, Kansas and Nebraska Railway, hence north along south right of way six hundred and sixty seven (.667) feet, hence east, plus hundred and sixty seven (.67) feet, hence south to place of beginning, has caused the same to be platted under the name of "First Addition to Aiken" and that the streets and alleys indicated on said plat are dedicated to public use, and that the lots and blocks shown thereon are reserved for sale.
