Hanson's Addition to Marguerite as shown by the foregoing plat is located in the South West corner of the North West Quarter (1/4) of the South West Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty Four (24) Town Seventeen (17) Range Five (5) West of the 6th P.M. and is described as follows: Beginning at the Sixteenth (1/16) Corner at the South West Corner of the North West Quarter (1/4) of said South West Quarter (1/4). Thence East one Sixteenth (1/16) Section line 366 feet. Thence South one Section line 504 feet to the place of beginning, and is divided into Blocks, Lots and Streets as shown by above plat. All Lots are 50 feet by 150 feet except Lots in Blocks 3 and 4 which are 36 feet by 150 feet. All Streets are 66 feet wide. Surveyed June 18th 1887
