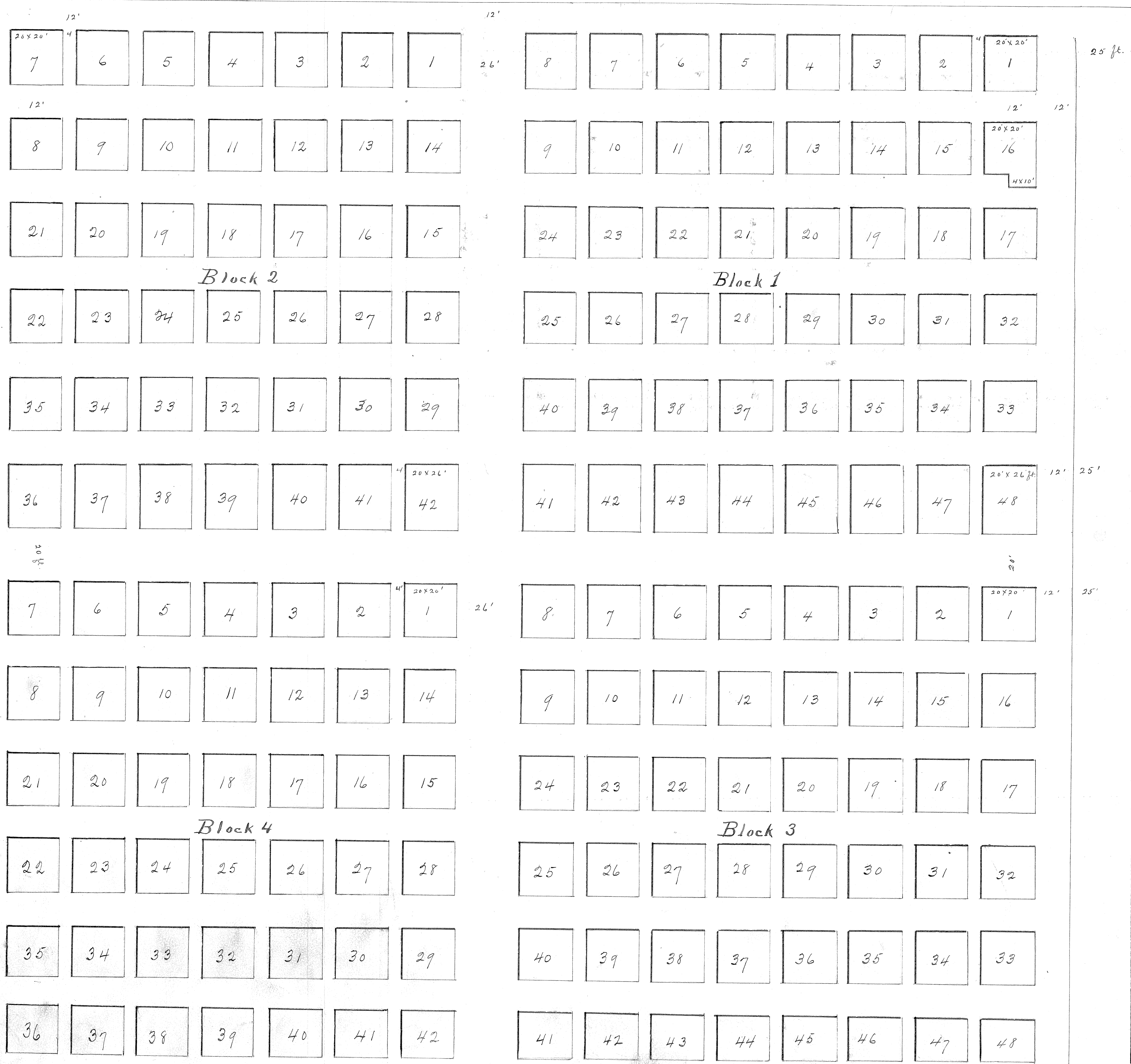


MOUND TOWNSHIP CEMETERY.



Commencing at the N. E. corner of the N.E. of Section 28, Township 21, South of Range 2 West of the 6th P.M. thence West 417 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ ft. South 417 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ ft. East 417 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ ft. North 417 ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ ft. to point of beginning. And I further proceeded to divide said tract of land except so much thereof as is occupied for public highway, as shown on this plat into four blocks and lots & alleys, all lots being 20 x 20 ft. except lots from 41 to 48, in blk one and lots No. 36 to 42 in blk two inclusive are 20 x 26 ft. alleys East & West are 12 ft wide, North & South 4 ft except 12 ft driveway on East side and 12 ft driveway on North side.
