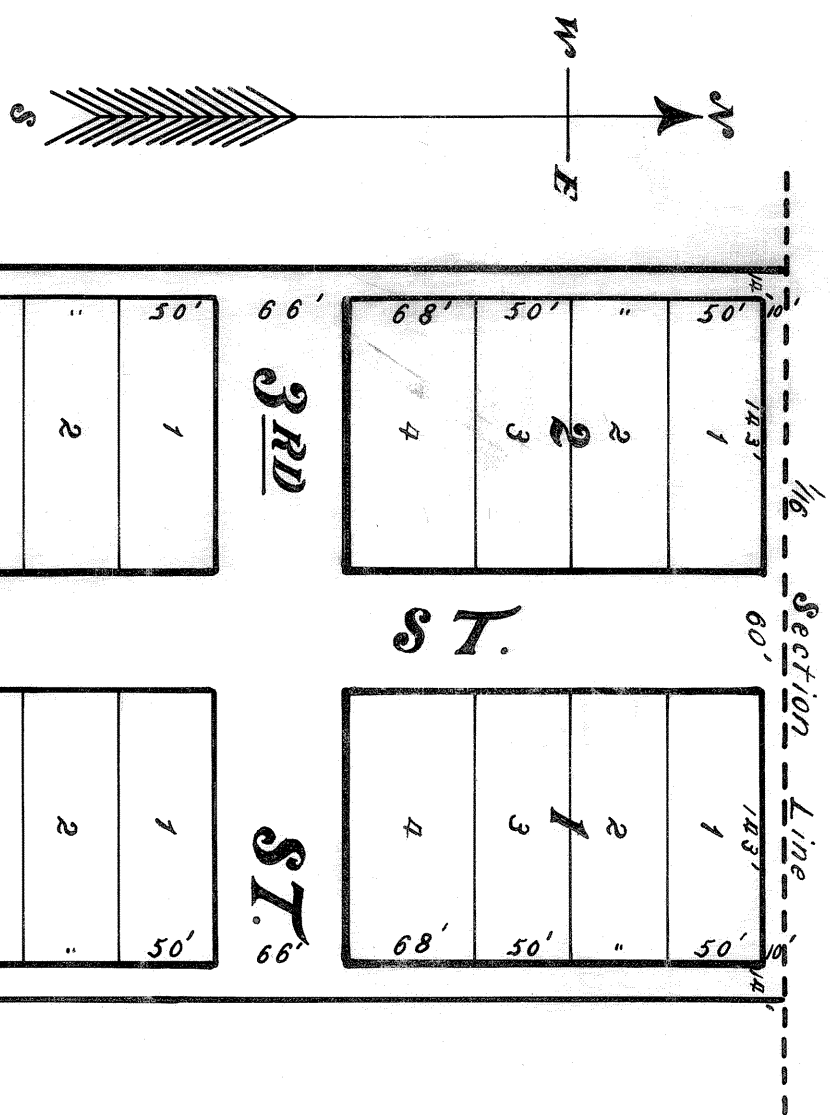


# OLSON'S FIRST ADDITION TO MARQUETTE, KANSAS.

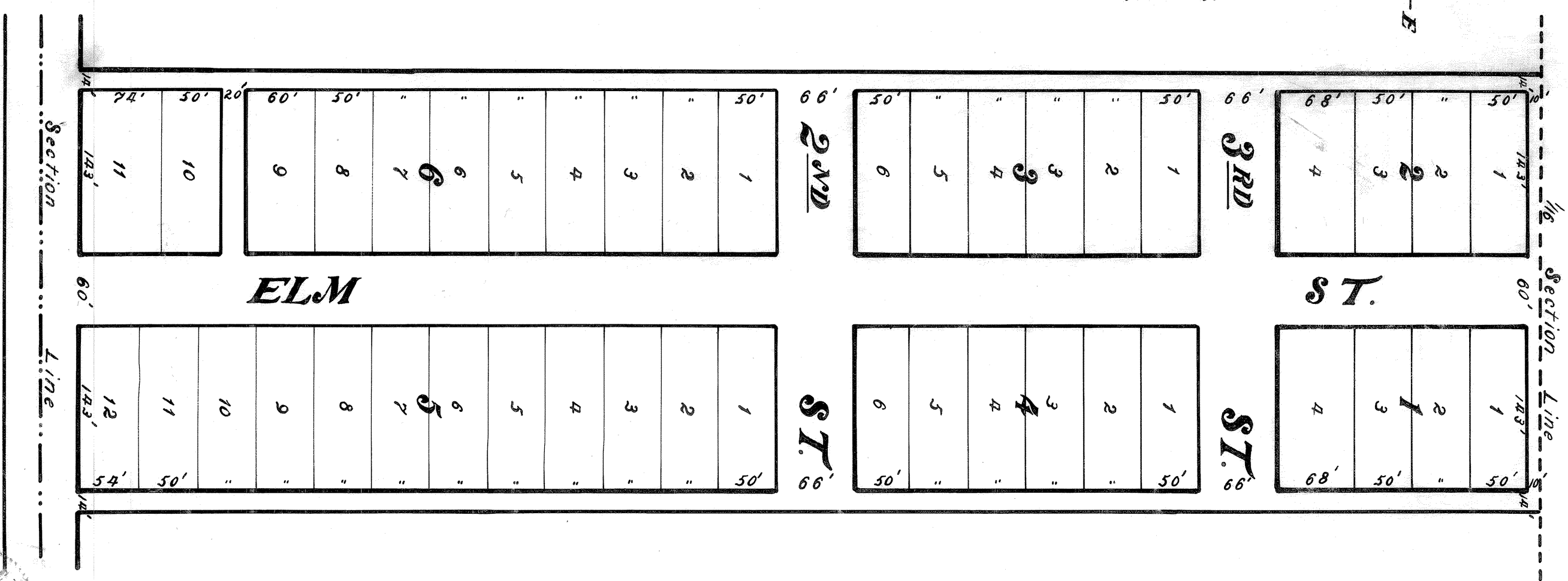
Olson's First Addition to Marquette Kansas is described as follows:

Commencing at the north west corner of the south west quarter (1/4) of the south west quarter (1/4) of the town twenty-four (24) in and of range five west of the 6th Principal Meridian. Thence east on 1/4 section line six hundred eighty six (686) feet to the place of beginning. Thence south N. 10° 40' E. three hundred sixty four feet Thence East N. 10° 14' E. Three hundred Seventy four (374) feet. Thence north Thence hundred sixty four (264) feet. Thence west Three hundred seventy four (374) feet to the place of beginning. The same is divided into lots, blocks, streets and alleys as is shown on the foregoing plat. The above described tract is a part of the south half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) of section twenty four (24) in town twenty four (24) south, and range five (5) west of the 6th P.M.
