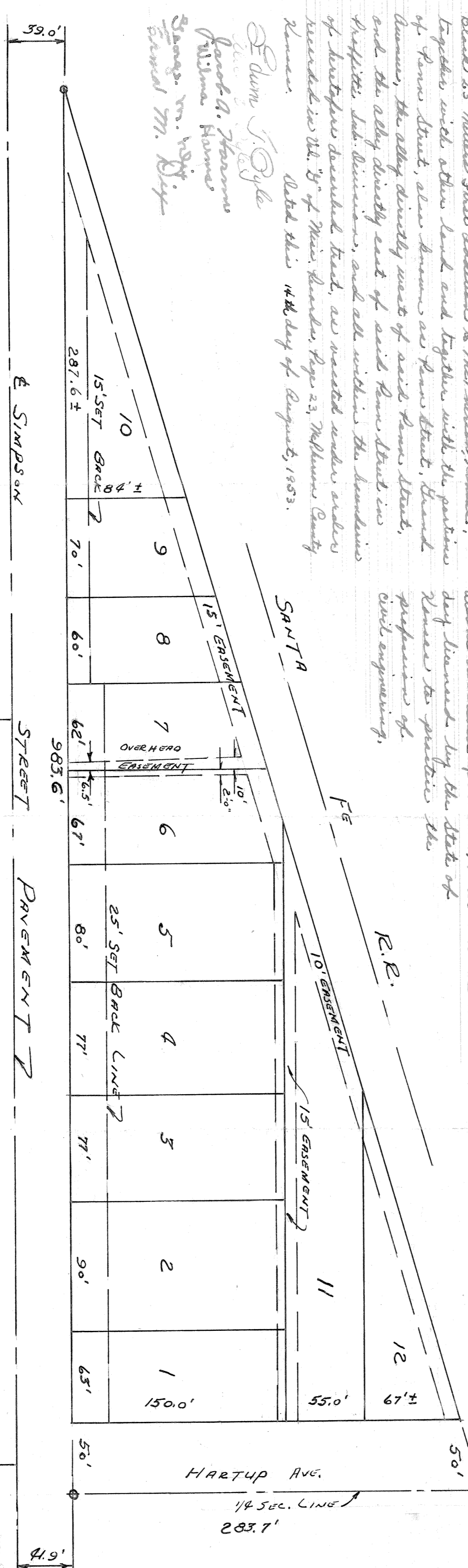


Know All these by their names, that Edwin J. Pyle and Oliver A. Pyle, his wife, Frank A. Rimmer and Oliver Rimmer, his wife, and George M. Ritz and Emma M. Ritz, his wife, owners and proprietors of the land hereinafter described, have caused said land to be surveyed and platted under the name of Pyle's Sub-Division of the City of McPherson, in McPherson County, Kansas, and have caused the same to be subdivided into lots, streets and easements as shown on the accompanying plat for public use.

Description:
 A part of the Northwest Quarter (N(1/4)) of section 28 Township 19 North, Range 3 West of the 6th P.M. divided as follows: Beginning at a point along the grade of section line about eight feet east of the northeast corner of lot six (6) Block One (1) subject to easements of the City of McPherson, thence along said line about 983.6 feet to the point of intersection with the north boundary line of the right of way of the Atchinson, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad Company, thence westerly on the south line of said right of way to a point about 283.7 feet north of the point of beginning, thence north to the point of beginning, being the land originally platted Block 25, Miller's Addition No. 1 to City of McPherson, and lots a portion of which were subdivided as "Pupples, Sub-Division of Lots 1, 2, 3 & 4 Block 25, Miller's Addition to McPherson, Kansas," together with other land and together with the portions of Pans Street, also known as Pans Street, Grand Avenue, the alley directly west of said Pans Street, and the alley directly east of said Pans Street in Pupples, Sub-Division, and all within the boundaries of heretofore described tract, as noted under order recorded in W. 5th of Main Plumber, Page 23, McPherson County Kansas. *Noted this 14th day of August, 1953.*
