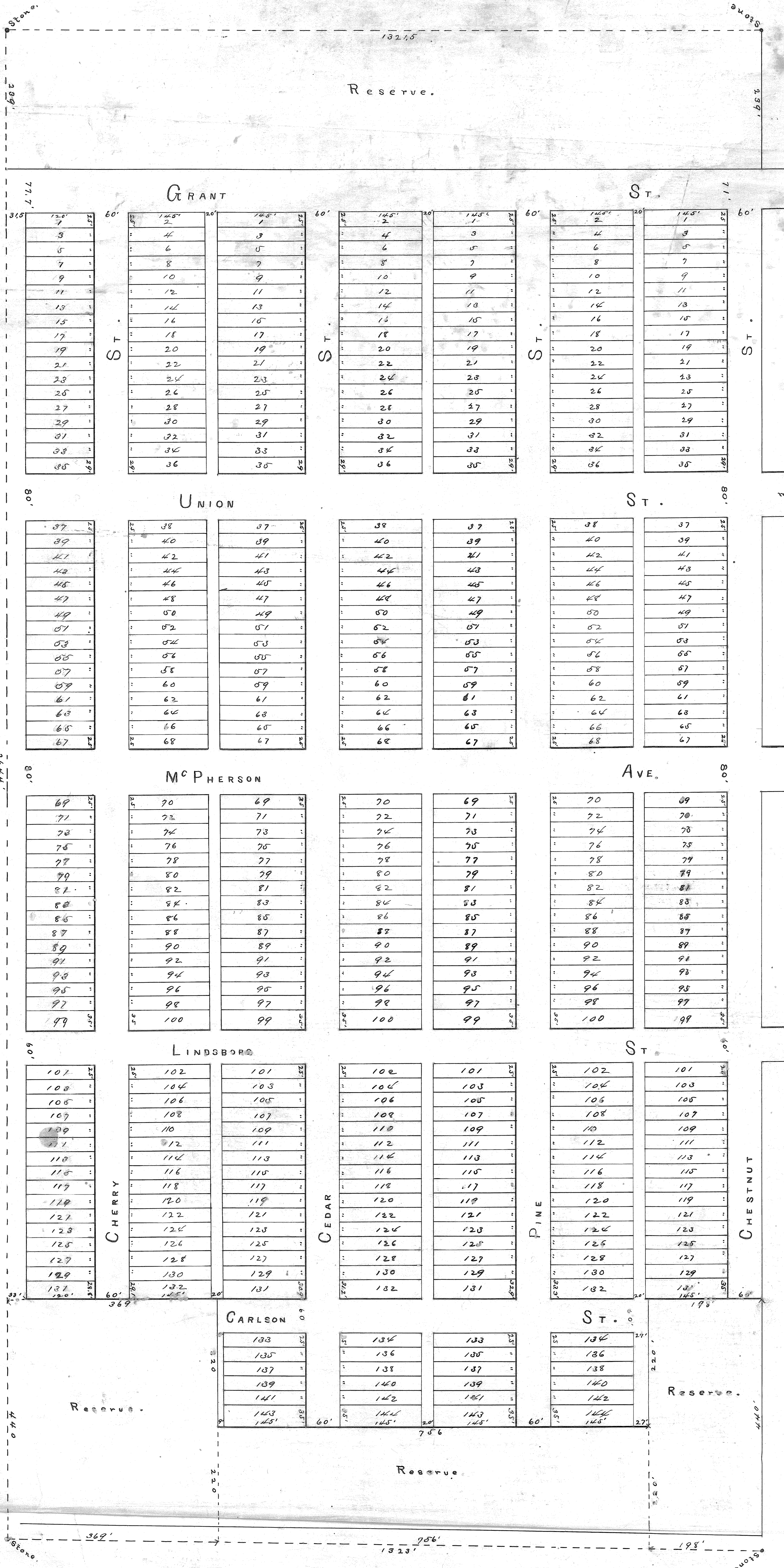

Beginning at a point 440 feet North of the South west corner of said Section 17; thence running North 196.5 feet; thence East 132 1/4 feet; thence South 196.5 feet; thence West 158 feet; thence South 220 feet; thence East 786 feet; thence North 220 feet; thence West 369 feet to place of beginning.
