

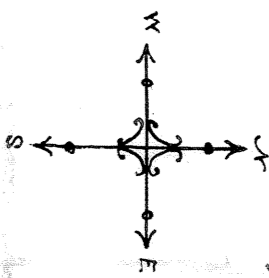

SW 1/4 OF SW 1/4 OF SEC 29 T17R4W OF 6TH PM.

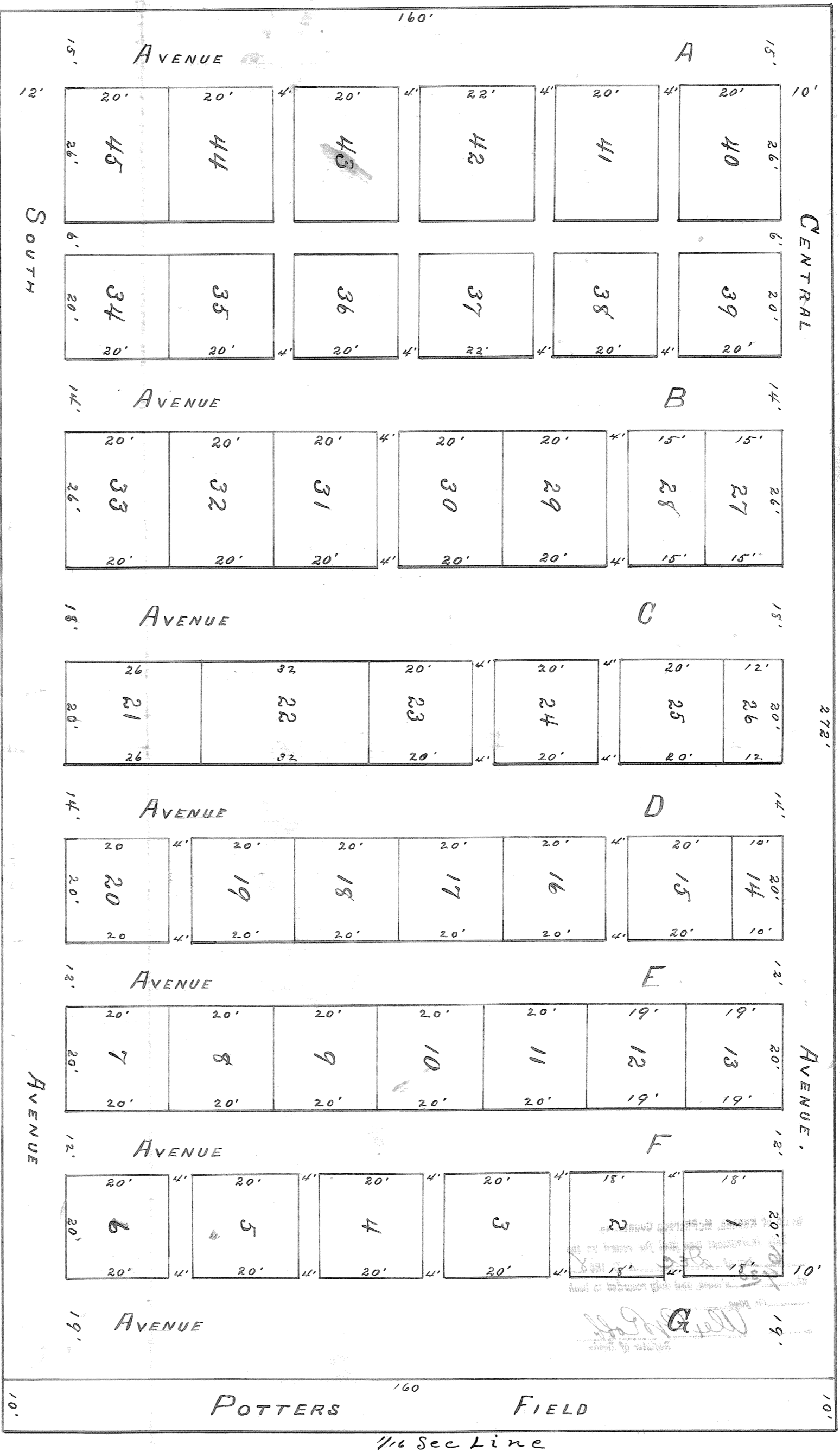

Stephens Cemetery, is situated in the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec 29 T17 R 4 W of the 6th PM in McPherson County Kansas, and is divided as follows, Beginning at a point on the 1/2 Sec line running east and south through the SW 1/4 of a parcel see 29, 102, feet south of the south line of a parcel see 29. Thence north 160 feet, Thence west (W 10° 50') 272 ft., Thence South 160 feet being divided into lots according to design and a lot designated as a "Widow's Field". The direction of which are shown by figures as represented in the above plat. Date of survey November 26th 1888.

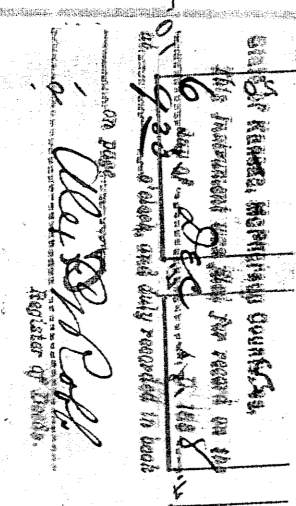
