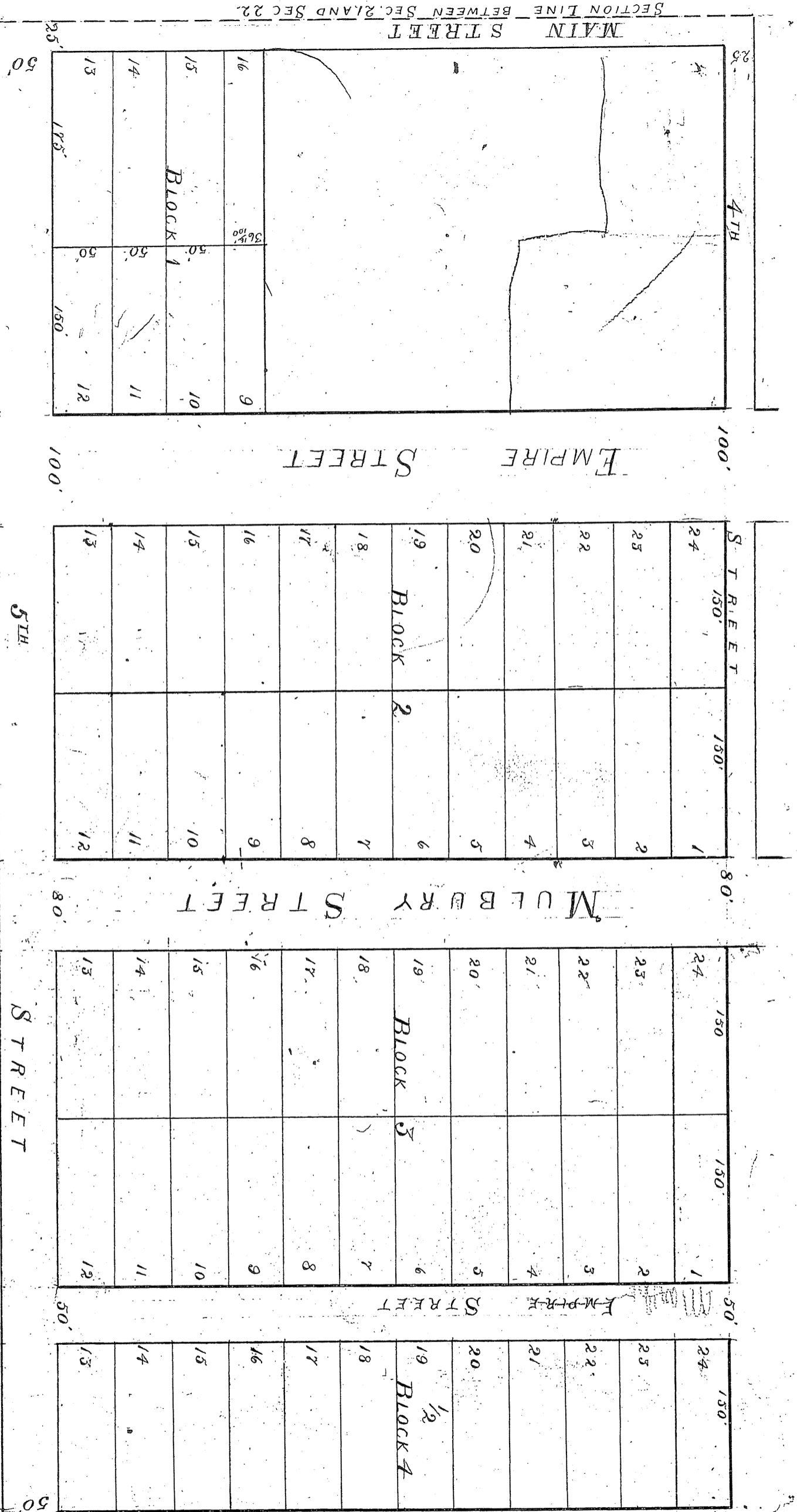


# STOUT'S ADDITION

Stout's Addition to Galena is situated on the South West Quarter of section 22 Town 19 Range 2 West of the 6th P.M. described as follows:—The initial point is the South West corner of St. 69 Main street Galena marked by a stone set in the ground. Thence West 50 feet to the section line thence south on Section line 675 feet thence East 1330 feet, Thence North 650 feet, Thence West 500 feet to the East line of Mulberry street—Thence North 25 feet, Thence West 830 feet to the place of beginning—The portion of Block 1 marked Plat Platted is not to be considered a part of this addition—The addition is divided into Blocks, lots and streets as shown in the above Plat. Blocks 2 and 3 are each 300 x 600 feet. 1/2 Block 4 is 150 x 600 ft. Block 1 is 325 x 186 1/2 feet; all lots are 50 x 150 feet except lots 13, 14 and 15 in Block 1 which are 50 x 175 feet, and lot 16 in Block 1 which is 36 1/2 x 175 ft. and lot 9 Block 1 which is 36 1/2 x 150 feet. Empire street and Mulberry street connect with and are continuations of the streets bearing the same name in Galena. The South West corner to Block 1, the South East corner to Block 3 and the North East corner to Block 3 are marked by white sand stone set in the ground.
